



COVID-19 Rules Update for The Barn 24/09/2020

Welcome to the ever changing World of Eating at The Barn. We are constantly following the Government's Guidelines for your experience at The Barn Almondbury.

Listed below are some key points that need to be observed and carried out to dine comfortably and safely at The Barn.

1. For all reservations we will require your Track & Trace contact details. (A QR sheet will be offered for you to scan if you have the current NHS covid-19 App, otherwise we will have taken your details on point of booking).
2. Masks/Face coverings have to be worn by all Front of House Staff and Customers not sat at a table. Kitchen staff must wear masks when leaving the kitchen. This means if you leave your table for any reason, please put your face covering on before you do so.
3. On entering and exiting The Barn (even to go outside or to the pub toilets) please use the sanitiser provided by both corridors.
4. When seated please remain seated whilst having dinner unless you need to go to the cloakroom / smoking area.
5. Access to the woolpack (other than using the cloakroom) is only allowed once you have left The Barn and you must access the Woolpack through their Entry System and adhere to their policies.
6. 10pm Closure. All UK Restaurants, Bars, Clubs and Pubs HAVE TO BE CLOSED at 10pm. Therefore we will be calling last drink orders at 930 pm and presenting all bills at 945pm to be settled. We cannot be held responsible for late taxis / lifts and sadly you will be requested to leave the building by 10pm.
